

Artist Statement

The drawn line

The drawn line as an original, minimal and immediate means of artistic expression and the surrounding space in the form of the A4 sheet of paper are my two central media.

As the `smallest unit´ of my artistic exploration, they are often the starting point for serial works, installations and site-specific projects.

With a conceptual approach and a reductive approach, I pose fundamental questions about the function and design possibilities of the line.

These are used to analyse everyday structures, existing pictorial motifs, writing and language.

This takes the form of controlled freehand outline drawings or serial constructions drawn with a ruler, for example, as well as word pictures made from alphabets of square or cubic lower-case letters specially developed by me for this purpose on the border between abstract and legible signs.

The focus is always on questioning perception and viewing habits with minimal means.

- . An a as Anfang (engl. beginning) of the (word) Anfang and an e as Ende (engl. end) of the (word) Ende from my `alphabet nr O´ form the bracket of the wall installation.
- . In between are vertical and horizontal bars.

 These form the building blocks that make up the two letters.
- . The letters a and e consist of one and the same character rotated by 180°. The entire mural forms an ambigram with 180° rotational symmetry and retains exactly the same shape and legibility when turned upside down.

 In this way, the e becomes an a and the end becomes Angang (engl. a beginning) again.
- . Playing cards to remove and collect were part of the exhibition.
- . This card shows my work for the exhibition and refers to a large project for which I was commissioned.
- . For the new museum currently under construction, I have been asked to design all the areas made of glass that are not to be touched. There are 8 large areas in the building, including all 3 entrance areas.
- . The Museum für konkrete Kunst und Design Ingolstadt will open in 2026.

. . .

Suppose a square grid is placed over a DIN A4 sheet (29.7 cm \times 21 cm). Is it possible to make a closed line tangent to all the squares in it once?

The series of solutions that led to symmetrical forms is exhibited here as an example. However, in order to emphasise that each composition is independent of the way in which it is hung, the resulting structures have been monogrammed and dated at their four corners (tlp / 2021).




Viewed as a whole, the series creates the illusion of almost fluid movement.


The line changes its course almost dynamically from sheet to sheet and thus becomes an animation.






Here works are shown which are based exclusively on the cubic alphabet `alphabet nr 5´ developed by me.

Legibility takes a back seat in favour of spatial constructions in serial sequences.

All my alphabets consist exclusively of lower-case letters - inscribed in a square or cubic basic shape. Only straight lines are used.


The intention behind the development of these alphabets lies on the one hand in the interest in language and writing in general and in the border area between letter and abstract sign in particular.




Thomas Laubenberger-Pletzer uses drawing to examine existing graphic structures of everyday life. He playfully subjects them to change, countering entrenched, one-dimensional perception with a multitude of alternatives that result from the graphic modification. The arrow as a signpost, statically always in the same position in the picture, is superimposed by other arrows or merges in collision with them to form a new, expanded outline. Arrows approach each other, turn away, create unwieldy relationships, plasticity and dynamism.





The sparseness of the means, the artist's tongue-in-cheek 'it-is-what-it-is' attitude are impressive. The labelling in the form of the naming of an existing exposed concrete wall and plaster wall - two seemingly familiar materials and elements - places these as objects themselves in the art context.

He develops his interventions meticulously, with great sensitivity, so that they contain a great deal of poetry despite their conceptual reduction. In a subtle and equally vehement way, he questions perceptions and superficially clear attributions; thinking along is encouraged, thinking further even more so. Coming from a philosophical background, he is interested in an in-depth examination of language and its significance as a central instrument of human communication. Semantic aspects as well as their representation in the form of cognitively recognisable signs are taken into account.





The light objects are printed with letters from my `alphabet nr 2' (one per sheet). These each form a combination of all six modal verbs (dürfen - müssen - wollen - sollen - mögen - können) with the word 'lesen' (e.g. lesen duerfen) - six objects in German and six objects in English. The backs of the lights form the passive versions (e.g. lesen duerfen).




